

## **Parent/Carer Agreement re dealing with Covid 19.**

It is obviously in the interests of everyone to adhere to the following guidelines at all times to ensure this setting can operate as safely as possible.

Please respect each other and be aware of distance.

- Do not give your child Calpol or similar before attending the session as this will interfere with temperature reading.
- Do not send your child if anyone in your household is showing signs of Covid 19.
- As far as possible do not send your child to another setting; if this needs to happen let us know immediately.
- Adults will socially distance using the 2 metre markings on the pavement while waiting to drop or collect their child.
- Discourage your child from bringing any toy into the building.
- Your child will need named soft shoes for indoor use and named outdoor shoes that will be changed on entering the building and left outside. Please send in a change of clothes and ensure that any bags can be wipe-cleaned.
- The child's keyperson will meet them at the bottom gate.
- Adults will need to operate a traffic light system for safe distancing up and down the path.
- If there are separation issues, the parent/carers and keyperson will move to the field area and discuss best course of action.
- Before entering the building, hands will be washed, supervised by staff. They will also be washed with soap and water once in the building.
- Staff and children will be given a coloured wrist band to wear which denotes their group. Groups will be kept separate and whenever possible play and activities will be outside.
- Parents/carers will be given staggered start and finish times. It is important to adhere to these. Do not just turn up late, you will be given a new time.
- A one-way system around the building using the outside paths will always be used by staff and parents/carers.
- If a child shows signs of Covid 19 they will, if possible, be kept outside with a member of staff until they are collected. Please collect promptly if contacted.

We appreciate that this new routine will take some getting used to so please be patient with one another, and with us. Thank you.

If anyone deliberately persists in behaviour that could endanger another, we will take serious action which could lead to the termination of your child's place.
